Our New National President of The Institution of Engineers (India), Kolkata **Mr. Ashok Kumar Basa**, FIE



Mr Ashok Kumar Basa, FIE, has been elected as the President of The Institution of Engineers (India) for the Session 2013-14, during the 677th Council Meeting of the Institution hosted by the Himachal Pradesh State Centre on September 28, 2013. Mr Ashok Kumar Basa (born in 1958) has topped in Civil Engineering from R. E. College (presently known as NIT), Rourkela, in 1980. He also won the Best All Rounder Gold Medal of the college. Mr Basa worked as an Assistant Engineer in Odisha PWD for

a brief period. In 1982, he joined B Engineers & Builders Limited, as Director (Technical). Presently, he is Managing Director of CEM Engineers & Consultants (P) Limited, Bhubaneswar.

Mr Basa designed and constructed the 1.8 km long flyover, the longest of its kind within the state near Cuttack Railway Station. Some important projects executed by Mr Basa are Indoor Stadium at Cuttack, 2 km long Pre-stressed Concrete Girder Bridge in Mahanadi Barrage near Cuttack, one of the longest bridges in Jharkhand across River Sakri, one of the longest Pedestrian Suspension Bridges across river Mahanadi near Dhabaleswar, 1.4 km long Railway Bridge across river Brahmani, etc. He was involved in the design and strengthening of a 200t capacity bridge(Lilari).

He had published fifteen papers in different national and international journals including IRC, Indian National Group of IABSE etc. He has also been appointed as a reviewer by IRC for a number of years. Mr Basa was co-editor of a book 'Rehabilitation & Retrofitting of Structure' brought out by IEI and published by MacMillan.

Winner of several awards, such as, Young Meritorious Engg. Award, Er S V Srinivasan Gold Medal of Odisha Engg. Congress, Gold Medal by the Odisha State Centre of IEI, Mr Basa was awarded with the prestigious IRC Medal for Best Paper in Construction in 2007. He also received the IRC Medal along with his colleague for his exemplary work in Brahmani Railway Bridge near Jenapur. He also received the prestigious Confederation of British Industry (CBI) Scholarship in 1990.

Mr Basa has been nominated by IRC as a member and inducted into different committees, such as, Foundation Engg. Committee, Pre-stressed, Reinforced & Composite Concrete Committee, Committee for Maintenance & Rehabilitation of Bridges, Flyover & Elevated Structures Committee, etc. He has also been the member of prestigious Bridge Specification & Standards Committee since 2003.

Mr Basa is an active member of IEI. He was the Honorary Secretary and Chairman of the Odisha State Centre of IEI in the session 2000-2002 and 2002-2004, respectively, and during his tenure as Chairman, the State Centre was adjudged Best Centre in 2003 by IEI. He was elected to the Council of the Institution representing the State of Odisha since 2004. He has been a member of various committees of IEI, such as, RCC, ICC, AITC, LBC, CATE, IMC-fib, IMC-WFEO, BYC, SPC, etc. He also worked in the Board of Governors of different Fora such as SDF, WMF, SQF. He has been the member of the Finance Committee for five times and Chairman, Civil Engineering Division Board for three times (2007, 2011, 2012), Chairman of SHMC (2010) and Chairman of EISC (2004).

As regards to his international presence, Mr Basa is a member of the Disaster Risk Management Committee of World Federation of Engineering Organization (WFEO). He presented a paper in Disaster Risk Management Pannel Session of WFEO in September 2011 in Geneva. In World Engineering Forum (WEF) 2012 in Slovenia, he was nominated as a 'Speaker' by WEF in which he highlighted India's emphasis on Disaster Management in developing Indian Tsunami Early Warning System (ITEWS) for prediction of Tsunami in Indian Ocean.

Mr. Ashok Kumar Basa will assume office as the President at the Ninety-fourth Annual General Meeting of the Institution scheduled to be held at Chennai on December 22, 2013.

Report on Three Members Inquiry Committee of Council Members Regarding Functioning of Bareilly Local Centre

To, President IE (I), Kolkata

In pursuance of the HQ Memo. No. SDG/SKB/054(22) dated 15-01-2014, the Inquiry Committee of three Council Members visited the Bareilly Local Centre on 07-03-2014. A joint meeting of the past and present Local Centre Committee members was called on that day. Mr. K. C. Agarwal and Mr. A.K. Jindal, Past Honorary Secretaries, who made joint representation pointing out certain discrepancies, shortcomings and violation of Bye-Laws and Regulations in the working of the Local Centre and working of Shri K. B. Agarwal, Chairman for session 2011-13, were specifically invited to attend. Shri A. K. Jindal, Past Honorary Secretary, attended the meeting but Shri K. C. Agarwal, Past Honorary Secretary did not attend the meeting and wanted a separate independent exclusive interaction with the Inquiry Committee, which was granted.

The joint meeting was attended by 14 members from the present Local Centre Committee (2013-15) and past Local Centre Committee (2011-12). There was open discussion on the grievances and working of the present and past Committees. The views of the members present were heard individually. Later on a separate meeting was held with Mr. K. C. Agarwal and Mr. A. K. Jindal to hear their grievances. In the evening a meeting of General House was also called to interact and hear the views of the general house regarding the working of the past and present Local Centre Executive Committees.

All the issues were deliberated, thread-bare and thoroughly discussed with the members in the above said meetings. The record and the past correspondence on the subject between different officers and office bearers was also studied. The report of the committee is as under:

"The functioning of the past Local Centre Committee was effected by the divergent views and approach to solve the teething troubles generally encountered while setting up a new Centre, between its then Chairman and Honorary Secretaries especially regarding the location of the office of the Local Centre. The above said issue has been solved as the headquarter of the Centre has now been shifted to new premises in the town by hiring a building on lease for six years. The premises of the new office building is also reasonably good, located at central place in the town, and the office has been set up and furnished properly. The new local Centre Committee 2013-15 has been elected unanimously in the presence of Chairman of the State Centre and a Senior Council member. The Committee has taken over and appears to be working satisfactorily. After long deliberation and on the advice of the Inquiry Committee both parties have now assured to work jointly without any malice, with a clean slate, in the interest of the Institution and the Local Centre forgetting the past. They have also assured to constitute a committee of the senior corporate members attached to the Centre, to find a suitable piece of land and arranging finances to have a building of their own in the near future."

In view of the facts above there appears to be no necessity to pursue matter further and the matter be dropped.

Inquiry Committee also directed Chairman & Honorary Secretary for merger old Bank account into new account of IE (I), Bareilly Local Centre.
